

## Kingston Maurward College - Accommodation Booking form 2021.

The College is situated in very attractive landscaped grounds approximately one and a half miles east of the town of Dorchester. The accommodation is in the Annexe containing sixteen rooms offering single and 2 twin and utilised during College term times for resident students. The accommodation is basic but comfortable with two sets of shared bathrooms, showers, toilet facilities and a communal kitchen shared among delegates. There is parking on the Campus. The price for bed and breakfast, including vat, is £40 per person per night or £30 per person if sharing a twin room. A full English breakfast will be provided in the Coach House café. There is also a café attached to the Animal Park where food can be purchased which is open between the hours of 10am and 4pm.

Access to the Gardens is included in the overnight charge but restricted to 10am to 5.30pm each day. Delegates should be aware there will be a private wedding taking place at KM on both Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> and Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July.

*The Thomas Hardy Society will organise transport during the week at 8.30am from KM to Sunninghill, returning at the end of the main evening event, the time of which will vary but usually between 10pm and 10.30pm. Arrangements for transport on the first Saturday and Sunday morning will be somewhat different as well as for Friday 9<sup>th</sup> July and Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2021.*
